LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Listen to short stories or poems.
- Note important details about the character, setting, and events.

DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES

Preparatory Activities

1. **Routinely Activities**
 - Prayers and Checking of Attendance.
2. **Review (suggestions only)**
 - Introduce yourself and get to know students.
3. **Motivation (suggestions only)**
 - Read different short stories to the students.
 - Ask them about important details about the characters, setting, and events in the story.

Presentation of Lesson

GENERALIZATION

Lead the students in identifying that:
