LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Listen to a variety of media including books, audiotapes videos, and other age-appropriate publications, characters, settings, and events.
- Give the correct sequence of events.

DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES

Preparatory Activities

- 1. Routinely Activities
 - Prayers and Checking of Attendance.
- 2. Review (suggestions only)
 - Introduce yourself and get to know students.
- 3. Motivation (suggestions only)
 - Read different stories to the students.
 - Ask the student to note important details about the characters, settings, and events in the stories.

Presentation of Lesson

Discuss the lesson using the **iPresentation** resource found within the interactive courseware to facilitate the learning on **PAGES 2-7**. Give the students some practice exercises or questions.

GENERALIZATION

Lead the students in identifying that:

- To learn information about a certain topic, you should know how to remember the details. This means you need to take note of the important information.
- Sequencing is putting things in order, from first to last. It is the ability to retell the events within a given text in the order in which they occurred.
- Sequencing refers to the identification of the components of a story the beginning, middle, and end.
